

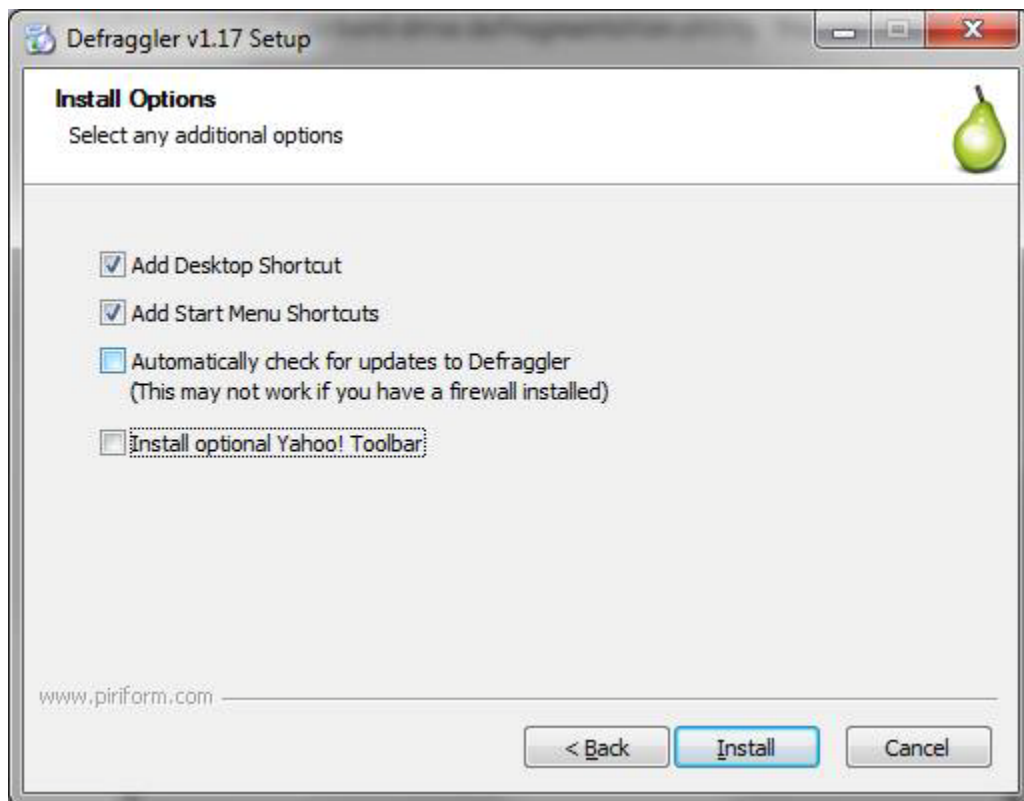
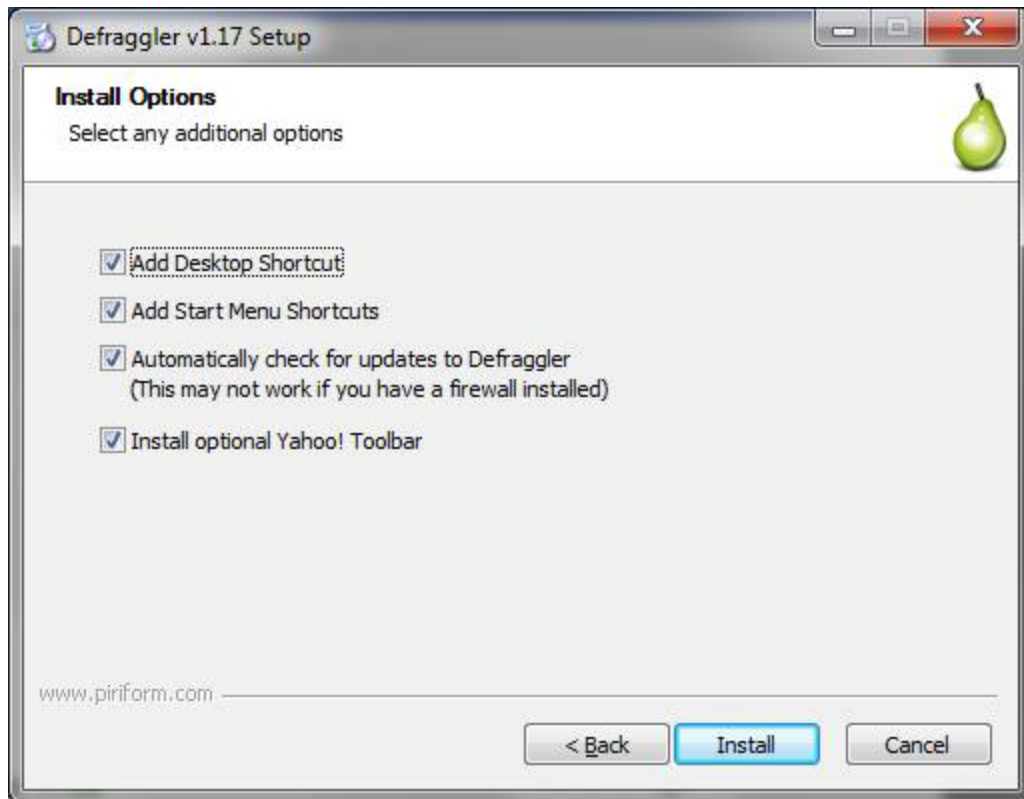

Defraggler

From the folks who brought you CCleaner comes a new utility: Defraggler. Defraggler is a free hard drive defragmentation utility. You can find it at:

When you download the program and run/install it, be careful to deselect two options on the installation screen shown below:



The next time you run the weekly job make sure you allow a search for new utilities. Then select Defraggler instead of the windows defragmenter program to run in your weekly job.

What is the current version of SOUP?

The current version, 9.5.35, of SOUP has been tested on Windows 7, Vista and XP without issue. Windows 7 and Vista users should use the TWEAKUAC utility (see web site download page) to minimize security messages at the launch of SOUP utilities. When you use TweakUAC, set it to "switch UAC to quite mode", the middle selection.

If you are not running this version, we strongly suggest that you run the SOUP Web Update Utility to get it. If you have any issues getting this update, simply uninstall your version of SOUP and download the current version from the Download page of the Synovative web site.
